- Drawing must be landscape orientation 8.5 X 11 in on white paper. See the example above.
- Students must fill the entire page
- All drawings must include a title with correct spelling and/or punctuation.
- All fields on the student entry form must be complete, please print legibly
- All drawings must include student's name, grade level, and school on the back of each submission.
- Paperclip the completed entry form to your drawing. Please do not staple or fold your artwork.


